

ADMISSION POLICY

Admission policy is as per guidelines of competent authority (DTE Maharashtra) & Pravesh Niyam Pradhikaran). Of the total intake capacity 80% seats are filled through centralised admission process (CAP) by the DTE Maharashtra. The remaining 20% is the institutional quota filled by the institute. The eligibility criteria for open as well as reserved category candidates are prescribed by the competent authority. The admission schedule is also announced by the competent authority.

First Year - Pharmacy	<p>(1) Maharashtra State Candidature Candidate. –</p> <p>(i) The Candidate should be an Indian National;</p> <p>(ii) Passed HSC or its equivalent examination with Physics and Mathematics as compulsory subjects along with one of the Chemistry or Biotechnology or Biology or Technical Vocational subject or Computer Science or Information Technology or Informatics Practices or Agriculture or Engineering Graphics or Business Studies , and obtained at least 45% marks (at least 40% marks, in case of Backward class categories, Economically Weaker Section and Persons with Disability candidates belonging to Maharashtra State only) in the above subjects taken together and The Candidate should have appeared in all the subjects in MHT-CET 2020 and</p> <p>(iii) should obtain non zero score in MHT-CET 2020.</p> <p>(2) NRI / OCI / PIO, Children of Indian workers in the Gulf countries, Foreign National. –</p> <p>(i) The candidate should have passed the HSC or its equivalent examination with Physics and Chemistry as compulsory subjects along with one of the Mathematics or Biology, and obtained at least 45 % marks in the above subjects taken together.</p>
Direct Second Year(Lateral Entry),- Pharmacy	<p>For Maharashtra State Candidature Candidate and All India Candidature Candidate, -</p> <p>(i) The candidate should be an Indian National;</p> <p>(ii) Passed Diploma Course in Pharmacy with at least 45% marks (at least 40% marks in case of candidates of Backward class categories, Economically Weaker Section and Persons with disability belonging to Maharashtra State only) from an All India Council for Technical Education or Pharmacy Council of India or Central or State Government approved Institution or its equivalent</p>
