## RAP Training Session for Final Year B.Pharm

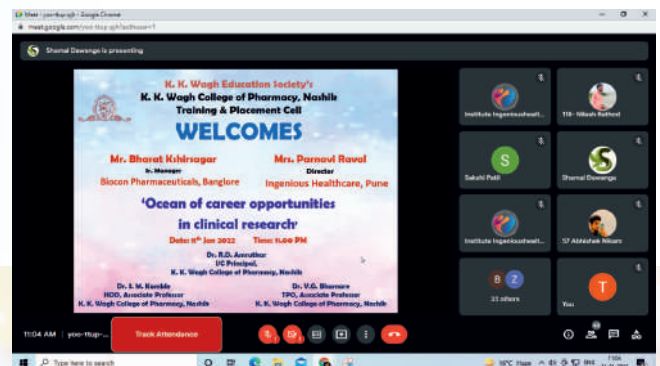


K.K. Wagh College in association with RAP analytical research and training centre organised a training session for advanced instruments such as HPLC, GC and UV- Spectrophotometer on the 7<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> Jan. 2022. Mr. Rohan Pawar (Director of RAP analytical research and training centre) discussed about UV-visible spectroscopy, Gas chromatography, and High-performance liquid chromatography. Principles, workings, instrumentation, and applications of all of these advanced instruments were discussed with specification emphasis on drug quantification using a UV-Visible spectrophotometer.

He also explained utility of HPLC and GC to separate, identify, and quantify each component in a combination. He also discussed daily life applications of these instruments. He explained to participants how to apply these good laboratory techniques into effect in regular practical sessions. He narrated the importance of GLP that can assist enterprises and research centres in maintaining product uniformity, consistency, reliability, reproducibility, quality, and integrity. Demonstration of HPLC, GC, and UV-Visible Spectrophotometer were conducted by staff at RAP Analytical Research and Training Center.

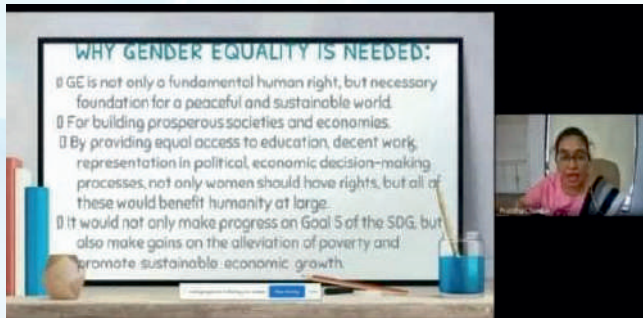

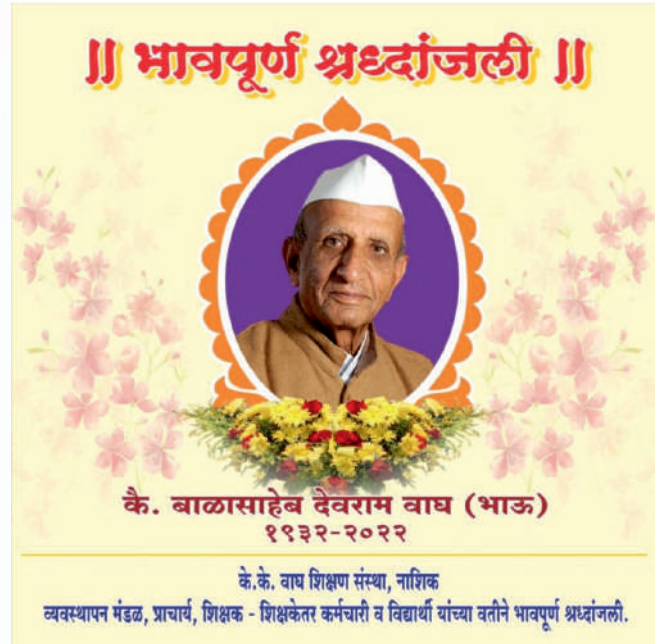
### Felicitation of Hon. Prof. Dr. Karbhari V. Kale, Vice Chancellor, DBATU Lonere

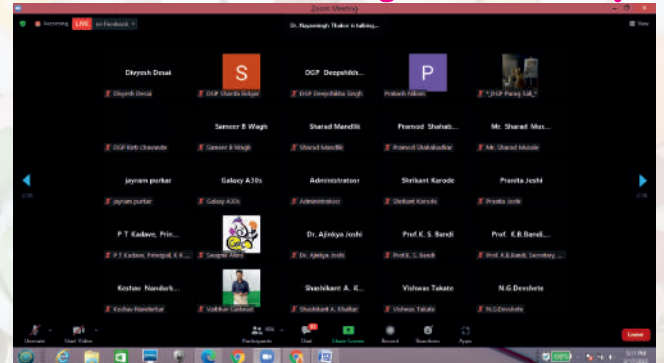

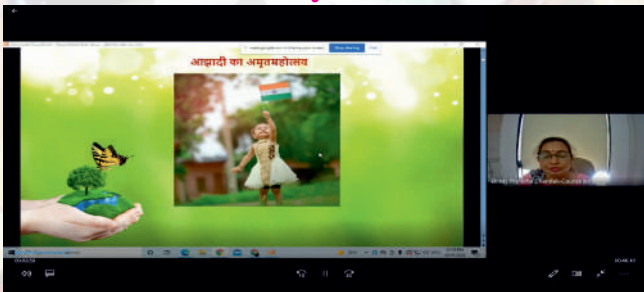

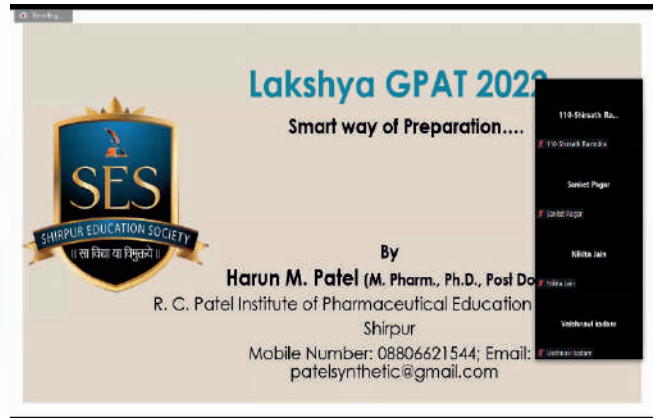
### National Girl Child Day

### Webinar on 'Lakshya GPAT 2022'

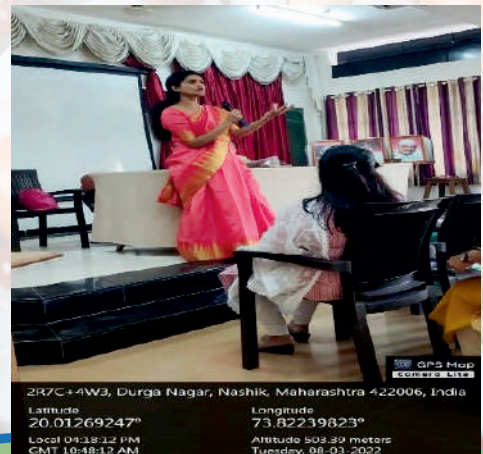

### Women's Day Celebration

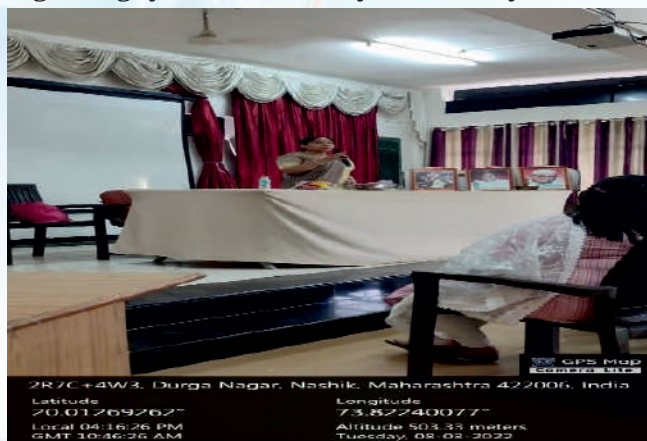
