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


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ABSTRACT: Stress is a complicated process that affects everyone differently. When the body is exposed to stressors, it initiates a series of coordinated responses called "stress responses," which include behavioral changes, immunological regulation, hormone release, and various physiological changes. Stress is the physiological response to risk or pressure, and it displays physically as fatigue or energy loss and psychologically as irritation or tension. 





The Swatantra Veer Savarkar Jayanti was celebrated on 28th May 2022 to commemorate the efforts of this former independence activist and politician.




